May I inform you that our foundation is organising a multi-cultural summer camp between 5 - 19 August, 2006.

This will be the second time the camp is arranged, growing to international dimensions now, and we would be very happy to have your country's involvement in the program. We are planning on to invite some eighty children between the ages of 10-15 to spend two weeks at a summer resort facility situated in Balatonlelle under the supervision of some twenty teachers and other professionals. The idea being that children learn the basics of tolerance through fun and games, handicraft, talks, quizzes and contests.
